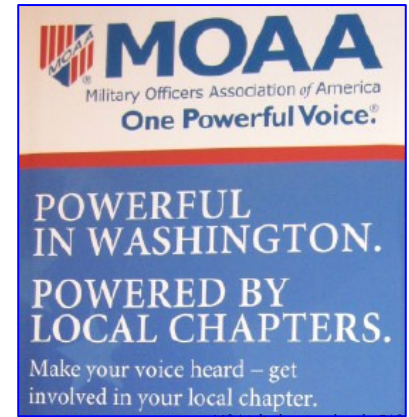
HELP SOLDIERS PHONE HOME:
