Colonel William "Willie" Brandt currently serves on the Joint Chiefs of Staff (JCS), **J5 Directorate**, as the Chief, Stability Operations and Civil Support Division, which is responsible for providing analyses, evaluations, and recommendations on policy, doctrine, and positions relating to stability operations, humanitarian and civil assistance, disaster response, and building partnerships to the Chairman of the JCS.

Colonel Brandt was commissioned in 1985 following his graduation from the University of Texas with a Bachelor's Degree in Geography. He attended pilot training at Laughlin AFB, TX and following flight training, remained at Laughlin AFB as a T-38 Instructor Pilot. He was a "Distinguished Graduate" of T-38 "Pilot Instructor Training." Following his Laughlin tour, he transitioned to flying the F-16 and received the "Commander's Trophy" as the Top Graduate of his F-16 training class. He is a command pilot and combat mission commander with more than **4,000 flying hours and flew in combat in Iraq and Bosnia**. In 2008, he assumed command of the 432d Operations Group / 432d Expeditionary Operations Group at Creech AFB, NV, which is **the only dedicated "Remotely Piloted Aircraft" Group in the Air Force**. The organization included seven assigned squadrons and 12 additional squadrons and provided training for and flew the MQ-1 Predator, MQ-9 Reaper in combat operations over Iraq and Afghanistan, as well as the RQ-90, a jet-powered, low-observation/ stealth UAV.

Col Brandt has Masters Degrees in Aeronautical Science and Strategic Studies. His awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit (one Oak Leaf Cluster), the Bronze Star, the Meritorious Service Medal (three Oak Leaf Clusters), the Air Medal (two Oak Leaf clusters), the Aerial Achievement Medal (one Oak Leaf Cluster), the Iraqi Campaign Medal (one Bronze Star), and the Kuwait Liberation Medal.

He is married to Lt. Col. Lynette Hebert, USAF, who is presently the commander of the recently formed 718<sup>th</sup> Intelligence Squadron at Langley AFB. She previously flew as a Mission Intelligence Coordinator with the MQ-1 and MQ-9 combat crews at Creech AFB while she and her husband were stationed there. They are the proud parents of 4 year old triplets, Austin, Catherine, and Isabelle.
